



Welcome to Year 3

Welcome back Year 3. We had another very busy and exciting term, and we are all very excited to start next term and do some more learning! This term we will develop our historical knowledge in our theme lessons. Our topic this term is 'Empires and Emperors'. In this topic children will learn about the history and structure of ancient Rome and the Roman Empire, including a detailed exploration of the Romanisation of Britain. We will also go on a trip to the Lunt Roman Fort to learn more about the Romans.

In our English lessons we will explore lots of different genres using lots of interesting texts. We will learn to write a letter and also do incidental writing. We will read 'Dear Earth' by Isabell Otter.


In Maths we will learn about angles and shapes, measures. We will further secure multiplication and division, explore calculating strategies and place value.





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In our whole class reading sessions in Summer 1 we will read 'Accidental Trouble Magnet' by Zainab Mian and 'The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe' By C.S Lewis in Summer 2. All the students will again have the opportunity to read alongside their teachers with their own copies that will be used in the class. Children will continue to learn 'Spanish' in a fun and interactive way and this term learn about fruits. In Science we will learn about plants, and it will link well with our Art lessons where we will learn about beautiful botanicals and mosaics. We will create our own greenhouse in our D&T lessons.



Planners

Children will be getting a new planner this term. Children are expected to bring their planner and reading book with them every day. Parents/carers please sign the planner on the correct date that your child has read. If your child reads something other than their school book, that's still great, but please sign to let us know they have done some reading. If a child has lost their planner, a new one will be charged and purchased through the school office.

Homework

Homework will be set every Thursday for completion on the following Tuesday. The children are expected to read daily with planners completed five times per week. For homework, a weekly task of Writing, Spelling, Maths and times tables, and Theme work will be given and expected to be completed by the following Wednesday, as stated above.

Spellings will be sent home once a week, on a Monday, and be tested on Friday. The spellings will also be available on Spelling shed. Please encourage your child to use Spelling shed regularly as this is a fantastic way to practice their spellings.

Reading

Reading is a priority in Year 3!

Please read with your child daily and record it in their planner. The planners will then be checked and signed by their teacher the following morning. Regular reading will help children to become more fluent, as well as helping them to understand what they are reading. This can be done by discussing the book afterwards, or during reading. Talk about the characters, setting or main events. The book children take home will be selected from the school's library and this will then be their only reading book.

PE

P.E will be on a Monday afternoon and so, children are required to come to school in their P.E kit instead of the normal school uniform.
