



## Nursery Funding Options

From September 2025

### What is everyone entitled to?

**All nursery children are entitled to 15 funded hours.** This means they will either attend a morning session (8:30am-11:30am) or an afternoon session (12:10pm to 3:10pm) every day. Once allocated, sessions cannot be changed.

### What may you be entitled to

You may be eligible for 30 funded hours. To find out if you are, visit [www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account](http://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account) to make an application. **If eligible you will receive a code which you must provide to the school.**

**Eligibility for 30 hours does not cover the full school day.** Therefore, there will be a charge of £3 per day to cover the extra time, or you may collect your child at 2:30pm. Payment will be made via the My Child At School (MCAS) app.

### Can my child attend for 30 hours even if we are not eligible for funding?

Yes, on a first come-first served basis, subject to availability. 15 of your hours will be covered by funding. You can then pay for the remaining hours at a cost of £90 per week or £18 per day in addition to the above £3 and any lunch costs.

### If my child stays for 30 hours, is lunch included?

No. You can either pay for a school meal at a cost of £2.40 per day (paid in advance on MCAS) or bring in a packed lunch for your child.
